Dear Justice Acosta,

I am writing to request an appointment to see you or a member of your staff about the July 26 letter I received from Jorge Dopico, Chief Attorney for the Attorney Grievance Committee. Upon information and belief, Mr. Dopico did not forward anything to “a board of lawyers and non-lawyers” as he states in the letter.

One of the reasons I think this is in the first paragraph of my June 21 letter requesting reconsideration of the decision dismissing my complaint against Alan Fuchsberg, Esq. Another reason is my correspondence with Charlotte Moses Fischman, Chair of the Attorney Grievance Committee. Ms. Fischman does not confirm that Mr. Dopico forwarded my June 21 letter to anyone. Ms. Fischman only says, “Mr. Dopico’s letter to you accurately states the status.”

The status of my complaint against Mr. Fuchsberg is that Mr. Dopico dismissed it, just as he dismissed my complaint against the General Counsel of Columbia University, which is why I made the Attorney Grievance Committee a defendant in my First Amendment lawsuit against Columbia University.
