I've attached the letter. Also, I discussed the matter on the telephone with Christopher Vogt. This is my follow up email:

Dear Christopher,

I've attempted to engage Fr. Robert Spitzer, Dr. Stephen Barr, and Cardinal Dolan in a discussion about the arguments for God's existence (Spitzer), thermodynamics and evolution (Barr), and the authenticity of the Holy Shroud (Dolan). They are not willing to have such a discussion or even answer my written explanation of their errors. As a result, I've filed canonical charges against Cardinal Dolan with the Holy Father and told the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith about Fr. Spitzer's errors. I've give the President of Fordham proof of delivery to the Congregation of the Doctrine of the Faith in my complaint to him about the lack of interest shown by Fordham's theology faculty.

What I want to do is explain to theologians at St. John's and Fordham why the Holy Shroud is not authentic, why the arguments for God's existence based on science are absurd, and why the American Journal of Physics should retract an article about evolution. Disagreements arise from different judgments about the evidence. The conflict between me and the Magis Center involves knowledge, intelligence, and integrity.
