Dear Christopher,

From our telephone conversation, I am hoping that you are reconsidering your decision not to invite me to give a seminar on the Shroud of Turin, proof of God's existence, and evolution. These are the subjects that the Magis Center disseminates misinformation about, not to evangelize, but to proselytize. This is called pseudoscience and is prohibited by Canon Law.

I think you should know that the article I recently submitted to The Historian ("Science, Metaphysics, Philosophy, History, and Theology of the Shroud of Turin") was initially submitted to the Italy section of the Institute of Electrical and Electronic Engineers for a conference that was held about the Shroud of Turin in Bari, Italy, in September of 2014. If I gave a presentation, my paper would have been published by the IEEE and considered to be a peer-reviewed science article.

My submission was not accepted, and I filed a complaint against the Italy section with the IEEE headquarters in the United States for practicing pseudoscience. The IEEE withdrew its support for the conference which meant that all of the papers submitted were not published by the IEEE. Had the papers been published, the Catholic Church could have been accused of pseudoscience because the misguided souls that organized the conference are advisors to the Catholic Church about the Shroud of Turin.

If you decide not to invite me, it will raise questions in my mind about not only about your understanding of fundamental theology, but of your character.

I spoke to your secretary today about my request in the attached pdf file to give a seminar at Fordham, St. John's, Seton Hall, or Georgetown.

I am hoping Christopher Vogt is reconsidering his negative decision. If my request is denied, I will tell the Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith and the Congregation for Institutes of Consecrated Life and Societies of Apostolic Life and speculate about your motives. These speculations will not reflect well on your integrity. I explained this to Christopher Vogt in our telephone conversation.

If denigrating the character of 123 Catholic theologians harms the Catholic Church or harms any of the 123, I don't want it to be on my conscience.
